PASSING GLANCE

ex Dauphine Ereine (Saints De Saint) Bay Colt | 09/05/20 Home Bred

First and only foal out of winning half-sister of Ryan Air Chase winner Dynaste. By Gr.2 Winner Passing Glance, National Hunt Progeny including Cheltenham Festival winner Attaglance. Other notable progeny includes Hint of Mint, Pass The Time and current star Dashel Drasher.

BLUE BRESIL

ex Ma Councha (Turgeon) Bay Colt | 17/04/20 Home Bred

Ma Counchas last progeny (a filly by Kapgarde) was sold for €28,000 at the store sales and is now in training with Fergal O'Brian. She is from the family of Gr 1 winner and now stallion Beaumec De Houelle. By the fashionable stallion Blue Bresil, Sire of Multiple Cheltenham Performers and 10 Individual National Hunt Black Type Winners to date.

ORDER OF ST GEORGE

ex Caras Way (Robins de Champ) Bay Filly | 21/01/20 Home Bred

This filly is out of a handicap hurdle winner Caras Way. The dam is a half-sister to two winners for JP McMannus (Movewiththetimes and Venture Capital). By the son of Galileo and Ascot Gold Cup Winner Order of St George. First crop foals in 2020 sold for €90,000, €68,000, €65,000, €58,000, €55,000 (filly) etc. She qualifies for 50% of the GBB prize money as she foaled here but is by an Irish based stallion.

BLUE BRESIL

ex Milan Athlete (Milan) Bay Colt | 16/04/20 Home Bred

Milan Athlete is the dam of Irish point-to-point winner Fameafterglory who sold for \in 100k. She is also full sister to multiple winner Real Milan. The Foal is also by fashionable stallion Blue Bresil. The colts ½ brother (by Sulamani and is a fouryear-old) is an exciting prospect and we have had good reports from trainer Jedd O'Keefe. The 2019 Getaway colt out of Milan Athlete made £29k as a foal last year.



MAHLER

ex Niceandspicey (Cloudings) Bay Colt | 01/05/20 Bought as a foal: €7,000

The dam is a half-sister to two black type horses, Fix the Rib for Gary Moore and Frascati Park for Nigel Twiston-Davies. The foal is also a son of Mahler. He has produced many black type geldings such as Ornua, Sutton Place and Chris's Dream to name a few. Mahler is Closely related to unbeaten 2,000 Guineas winner Footstepsinthesand and European Champion 2YO filly Superstar Leo.

BLUE BRESIL

ex Rosa Damascena (Kalanisi) Bay Filly | 06/05/20 Home Bred

Rosa Damascena is out of a half-sister to Gr 3 winner and now stallion Norse Dancer. She was a winner for the McNeill family. Her half-sister Early Morning Rain has had multiple wins in training with Jamie Snowden. This yearling filly qualifies for 100% of the prize money offered by the GBB scheme as she is by a (then) British based stallion and out of a British based mare. This will be appealing to buyers at the sales.

MAHLER

ex Chouquette (Fame and Glory) Chestnut Filly | 12/04/20 Bought as a foal: €4,500

Out of the half-sister to multiple black type horses, including Hell's Kitchen, Militarian and the exciting novice hurdle winner Lord of Kerak, currently in training with Olly Murphy. The Sire (Mahler) is by Galileo and has produced multiple top class mares including Miss Parfois and more recently Annie Mc. With multiple black type progeny and success at the sales with many selling for over £100k.





Peel Bloodstock has created this pinhooking syndicate as an investment and a way for more people to be involved in younger stock. The syndicate has taken ownership of seven yearlings chosen by Peel Bloodstock and are based at Peel Hall. The yearlings have either been bred by Peel Hall stud or purchased as a foal. The aim is to sell them in the summer of 2023 as store horses.

At Peel Bloodstock we are equipped and specialised to condition the horses to prepare them for the sale sand their racing career after. Each share is £2,000 +VAT (100 shares available). This investment will be a one-off payment; it includes cost of the foals, livery, transport, vets, sales entries etc. Peel Bloodstock will waver the usual 5% consignment fee if the investment does not make £200,000 or more. If the syndicate makes £201,000 to £250,00 the 5% will be established. If the investment makes £251,000 to £300,000 the rate will increase to 7.5% and if the returns are greater than £300,000 then a 10% rate will be implemented.

Being based in the UK and strong supporters of British breeding, Peel Bloodstock register all our fillies who qualify for the GBB scheme.
